Noxious Controlled: Common Cocklebur, Dyer's Woad, Ox-eye Daisy, Thistles, Purple Loosestrife, Perennial Pepperweed, Whitetop, Houndstongue, Field Bindweed, Toadflax, Russian Knapweed

Other Information: High Rates greater than 1 ounce can harm some grass species
