

Pesticide Profile: Telar XP

Type of Pesticide: Herbicide

Active Ingredient: Chlorsulfuron

Formulation: Chlorsulfuron 75%, Inert 25%

Other Trade Names: Glean

Sites of Applications: Rangeland, Pastures, Non-Crop, Industrial, ROW

Restricted Use Pesticide: No

Signal Word: Caution

Personal Protective Equipment: Long-sleeved shirt, pants, shoes, socks, Chemical-resistant gloves

Grazing Restriction: None

Replant Restriction: Grass-1-6 months depending on species

Harvest Restriction: None

Post-Emergent Restriction: Wait until grasses are well established

Other Label Restrictions: if applied by broadcast, do not apply more than ½ ounce/acre per year

Rainfast: 4 hours

Noxious Controlled: Whitetop, Thistles, Common Tansy, Dyer's Woad, Houndstongue, Perennial Pepperweed, Russian Knapweed

Other Information: Can harm grasses especially at rates higher than 1 ounce, so check label for rates and species before application
